# **ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2022**

## Achievement 1:

The successful implementation of the football court in Mghayrieh has made a significant impact on the local community, providing young people with a safe and accessible space to engage in physical activity and social interaction.

This project has fulfilled one of the key needs identified through the needs assessment and has demonstrated the commitment of the Youth RESOLVE 2 project consortium to empower youth and contribute to social stability in Lebanon.

# Achievement 2:

In addition to the successful implementation of the football court in Mghayrieh, the Youth RESOLVE 2 project consortium also conducted a capacity-building sessions for the youth committees in Saida, Bqosta, Barja, and Mghayrieh.

The sessions focused on "needs assessment, data collection, data analysis, and reporting as well as project management and strategic planning, fundraising, and team building", providing the youth with the skills and knowledge to lead the implementation of quick-impact projects in their communities.

This capacity-building sessions has not only helped the youth to identify the most pressing needs in their communities, but it has also equipped them with the tools to effectively plan and execute their projects. This is a testament to the consortium's commitment to empowering youth and promoting active participation in decision-making processes.

# **ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2022**

- The team established 21 Community Committees in Nabatieh, South and Mount Lebanon governorates that are independently able with their communities support to meet, lead, and set-up their needs sustainably ensuring gender balance between members.
- The team was able to complete our interventions although many municipalities were refusing our interference since we were not able to meet their demands in providing similar aid to the Lebanese community.
- After completing 6 successful public events, the demand from different municipalities increased to conduct a public event in their area. Although we had budget-cut, the team insisted on completing 2 more public events.
- As a part of sustainable interventions, the team constructed 3 ABR systems in informal settlements and installed 9 wastewater piping networks in 9 informal settlements to connect them to existing wastewater treatment plants.
- DPNA team actively worked to limit the spread of cholera cases in Syrian refugees informal settlements. To help prevent the spread of cholera in these informal settlements, hygiene kits were provided to households in addition to hygiene promotion sessions to individuals on how to properly maintain hygiene to prevent the spread of the disease.
- These efforts were crucial in ensuring the health and safety of the refugees and in limiting the spread of cholera in these communities.

# **ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2022**

Throughout 2022, a growing number of beneficiaries sought out the legal services provided by the help desk, resulting in the main goal of the project, the right to access justice, being accomplished a series of meetings, including meetings with key stakeholders in the south and Saida, as well as local and international NGOs, were conducted.

Awareness sessions covering all legal subjects were provided throughout the south area to ensure citizens have basic knowledge about their legal rights.

# **ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2022**

The digital literacy training sessions and the two women empowerment workshops built a learning approach coupled with networking and advocacy initiatives at the end. The women learned how to enhance their skills, how to boost their income-generation opportunities, and how to be themselves. The participants were given different skills and tools that could stand as potential key elements of their newly generated independent life that the workshops intend to carry out. The team received positive feedback about the workshops and the digital literacy training sessions, the women are looking forward to any upcoming training and potential work that could enhance their skills even more. With the final activity of the project, the initiatives succeeded and gave the women the feeling of responsibility towards their community; hence, a motif that will always encourage them to aid their community.

# **ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2022**

Almost 1000 beneficiaries had benefited from the PSS project in Mount Lebanon. We pursued and supported over 150 referrals to enhance their cases and follow up to ensure that children are protected from violence and harm, particularly in their communities. Aiming to support more than 50 children who had dropped out of school and are engaging in child labor in order to allow them to be enrolled in education programs and to enhance their living standards. Our goal was to turn the center into a community center where all the locals could share their cases and problems, and we reached 100 walk-ins to offer them support, especially psychological support for children and youth. As the first organization to intervene in Mount Lebanon's PFA program, DPNA established three PFA focal groups across various areas and is continuing to do so.

# **ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2022**

### PLATFORM DEVELOPMENT

After coordinating with project partners from Egypt and Palestine, content creators, website designers, and graphic designers, a platform that serves as a guide for entrepreneurs to open their own business is currently in its development phase. This plays a major role in inspiring young adults in improving the economy especially following the ongoing economic crisis in Lebanon.

### TRAINING SESSIONS

Various meetings and sessions with trainers took place that helped in the team members' capacity building. The topics tackled marketing, technical and pedagogical aspects for them to study each market thus offer beneficiaries the proper material accordingly.

### **COORDINATION MEETINGS**

Two coordination meetings took place in Amman, Jordan. The first took place in May 2022 to plan forward, gather suggestions, etc. As for the 2nd meeting it took place in December 2022 and served as an evaluation for the previous implementation year in addition to planning for the remaining period.
